

LANDSCAPE QUILT SUPPLY LIST

PATTERNS: Lots of choices here, inspirational scenes are everywhere, from greeting cards, to magazine photos to your own backyard. Or be extra creative and just use your imagination.

FABRICS: Background fabrics that are dark work very well as well as hand dyed or Batiks are also a good choice but if you insist on your sky being blue, bring that. You will need one yard to get you started.

Foreground: Decide if you want to create a woodland scene, desert, ocean landscape or maybe just flowers or grasses. Don't stress out over this as most of it will be covered as you create your scene. Bring 1/2 yard.

Other fabrics: bring a large amount of flowers in all sizes, rocks, animals, birds and foliage, fat quarters work very well. In landscape quilting, more is better so clean out that stash!

TOOLS AND NOTIONS:

Small scissors with sharp points, these are critical for landscape quilting

Sewing/craft glue stick, bring at least two AND/OR

Can of fabric adhesive spray

Pins: I like to use the longer size, bring at least one full box.

Basic sewing items, scissors, pins, etc.

OPITIONAL: In this class we will be working on creating your wall hanging and you will go home with it ready to sew it at home, however for you speedy quilters you may want to start this process in the workshop. If so bring:

Sewing Machine in good working order pre threaded with nylon thread, the bobbin should have an all purpose thread that matches your background. I use a size 80 (12) needle but if the thread breaks I switch to a Metafil needle. You will also be using a darning foot or big foot.

Optional:

If you have a portable design wall by all means bring it. I will have mine available.
