

## APPLIQUE WORKSHOP

### SUPPLIES:

Sewing Machine

Open toe or zigzag foot

Scissors: regular for fabric and small curved scissors

Iron and an ironing mat

Threads: YLI Nylon Monofilament, .004, Rayon #40, Fine cotton thread #60, black embr. floss

Stabilizer: notebook paper

Fusible Web

Freezer Paper

Fusible interfacing, lightweight

Straw or fast Turn Tubes with a ballpoint bodkin

Point Turner or Seam Creaser

Spray Starch

Craft Brush

Wooden pointed tool

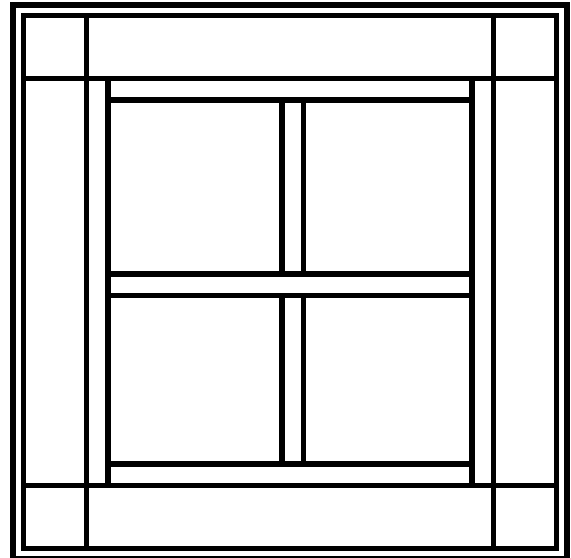
Water-soluble fabric glue stick

Roxanne Glue Baste

Rotary Cutter, Mat and Ruler

Hand Applique needles

Some flathead pins

### MATERIALS:

#### Cotton Fabric @ 44"

Requirements:

Background Blocks and Second Border 7/8 yd

First Borders, Sashing and Corners 3/8 yd

Binding 3/8 yd

Vine 1/2 yd

Backing and batting: 1 yard each

For the appliques use about 6 different kinds of fabric scraps, including leftovers from the border, binding and vine.

Cutting (1/4" seam allowances are included): wait to cut borders, sashing and corners

From the Background fabric cut: **Blocks: 4 @ 10" x 10"**

**Second Border: 4 @ 4" x 25"**(25"=approx.)

**First Border: 2 @ 1 1/2" x 25", 2 @ 1 1/2" x 23"**

**Sashing and 1 @ 1 1/2" x 23" and 2 @ 1 1/2" x 11"**(25", 23" 11" are approx.)

**Corners: 4 @ 4" x 4"**.

From the Binding fabric cut:

**Binding 4 widths of fabric @ 2 1/2"** for a double folded binding.

**Vines:** cut approximately 125" @ 1" of continuous bias, (for instructions see hand-out.)
