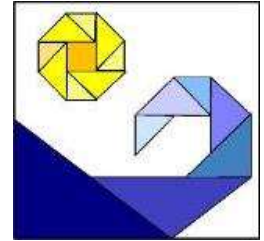


# Quilters by the Sea

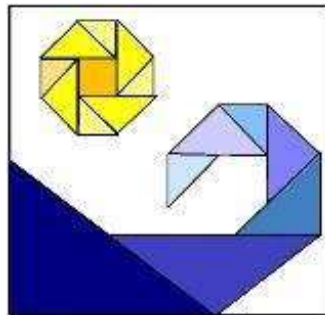
