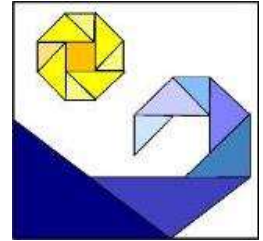

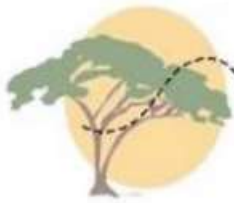

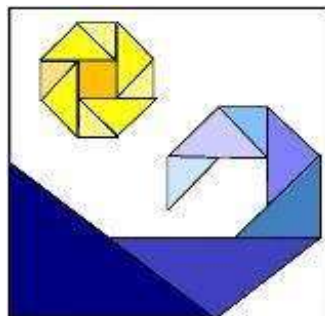

"Go wild with your stash! This is also layer cake friendly. Create this modern frog block using the "**Middle to Middle Piecing**" method which makes sewing the frogs deceptively simple. Cutting with templates and sewing triangles is fast and easy. **NO matching points, NO tiny pieces, NO tricky triangles, NO paper piecing.**

## *Infrognito Yardages*

(based on nondirectional 42"-widths)

### **For Smaller Quilt 33' x 42"**

**Frog bodies:** assorted coordinating bright prints, or tone-on-tones.

Body fabrics (5)..... **1/4 yard each**

*OR: seventeen assorted 10" layer cake squares*

**Frog backgrounds:** warm yellow tone-on-tones in in several values

Background fabrics (5)..... **1/4 yard each**

AND an extra fat eighth of one for appliqué frog block

**Borders:** Yellow solid or tone on tone ..... **5/8 yard**

### **For Larger Quilt- 42" x 60"**

**Frog bodies:** assorted coordinating bright prints, or tone-on-tones.

Body fabrics (7) ..... **1/4 yard each**

*OR: twenty-six assorted 10" layer cake squares*

**Frog backgrounds:** warm yellow tone-on-tones in in several values

Background fabrics (6) ..... **1/3 yard each**

AND an extra fat eighth of one for appliqué frog block

**Borders:** Yellow solid or tone on tone ..... **7/8 yard**

### **For Both Sizes**

**Appliqué frog:** approx. 8"x 8" pieces of two or three coordinating fabrics

**Bellies:** assorted coordinating fabrics ..... a 3 1/2" x 6" piece for each frog

*(If purchasing buy 1/8 yard pieces and cut several bellies from each fabric.*

*You may use some body fabric remnants.)*

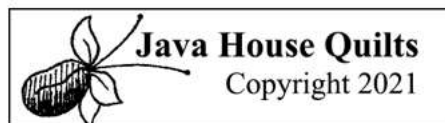
**Eyes:** use fabrics above and small additional pieces of contrasting solids

**Binding:** Small Quilt: ..... **1/3 yard** Larger Quilt: ..... **5/8 yard**

**Batting & Batting:** to fit finished project.

**Also needed:** basic quilting & sewing tools, threads, etc.; heavy-duty spray starch; Bohin or Sewline fabric glue pen (*NOT a glue-baste-it product!*) scissors for fabric and paper; 8" square ruler; mechanical pencil for tracing and marking; rotating cutting mat (*This is optional but nice to have.*)
