Thank you for your generous support of our guild. It is so gratifying to see the amount of caring shared not only for


one another but for our charities. Hope to "see" you in 2022.

There have been payments provided to various guild members for expenditures allowed as described in the By-Laws such as reimbursement for Community Relations supplies but no additional remuneration was provided for time or services.
