Quilters by the Sea will be meeting in person

March 8, 2022 7-9pm Guild Meeting

I am so happy to welcome everyone back to our first in-person meeting in two years! I look forward to renewing old friendships and making new ones. Just as there will be old and new friendships, our meetings will have some old and new ways of doing things.

The biggest change is a new meeting room at our old meeting place, Arbor Road Church. We will be meeting in McPherson Chapel on the west side of the church property with adjacent parking in front. McPherson is a more intimate space, closer to parking, at ground level (no elevator) and has cell phone reception!

Our meetings will follow the established agenda: officer reports, speaker, break, and then Show and Tell. Guild committees will have displays and information just like before: Workshops, Community Relations, Library (bring some change!), Programs, 2023 Quit Show, UFO Challenge, Round Robbin and our 2022 Opportunity Quilt (on display). What's different? We'll be seated in rows and the stage is three steps up, not seven. There will not be a refreshment center (no food or drink will be served at this time); members may bring their own snacks and beverages.

Workshop location and parking has not changed. Board meetings will continue via Zoom.

We will meet in McPherson through June when we'll decide if it is a better location for us.

A note regarding in person meeting; while we recommend and strongly appreciate mask wearing, Quilters by the Sea is not requiring members to wear masks. All members deserve respect for their personal masking decision. Finally, as much as we love you and want to see

your Show and Tell projects, please do not attend if you are ill, or just think you may be "coming down with something."





Describe the finished quilts on the form. Make sure that #1 is the one you want to work on first, #2 is the second one you want to finish, etc. Give enough information to easily identify each quilt. Fill out two copies of the list and keep one for yourself so you remember what to work on next.

Finished means quilted, bound and labeled.

The first quilt is due at the meeting March 10th (if we are back on Zoom, you'll present it on camera)

I'll record that you've finished each quilt, and in December, we'll have a prize drawing for those who completed all 4 quilts, BUT you're real reward is FOUR FINISHED QUILTS TO KEEP OR GIVE AS GIFTS.
