
## Pattern for Paper Pieced Kitty Mug Rug



## **Materials**

Lt Green 1 @ 3"  $x \rightarrow$ Lt Tan 1 @ 4"  $x \rightarrow$ Brown 1 @ 4"  $x \rightarrow$ 

Pink 1 2 1/2" square or 1 @ 2 1/2"  $x \rightarrow$ 

Black 2 2" squares or 1 @ 2"  $x \rightarrow$ 

9 x 9 scrap for backing

9 x 9 scrap thin batting

Flat-head pins (glass is preferred, but not req'd)

Index card (3 x 5 or 5 x 8 is fine)

Thread to match face and background

**High-level Directions** 

Use the Easy-peasy Paper Piecing technique to construct the 6 sections and <u>trim on the dotted lines</u>. Do NOT trim on the inside solid lines!

Sew sections 2,3, and 4 together, removing pins from each section as you go. Remove the pins from the other sections and sew the sections together in order.

Center the pieced top on the backing, right sides together.

Place the batting on top of the backing.

Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew around all four sides, <u>leaving a 2" opening on one of the sides</u>. Slightly trim corners.

Turn and square corners; Pin the opening closed or use a small piece of 1/4" double-sided fusible tape to iron the opening closed.

A quilting foot is nice for the final steps, but not mandatory. Using thread to match the sections, sew 1/8" around the entire Kitty face. With matching thread, stitch-in-the-ditch around the details of the face.
