



This year, we will be limiting your show and tell items, at the guild meeting, to a maximum of two. You will still need to fill out the form at the meeting, from the



Alan Calgaro made these two quilts. The one on the left is "Checkered Stripes". The one on the right is "Water Lilies". Both still need quilting to be finished.





These two quilts are from Kate Weber. The one on the left is "Blue Mood" tumbling blocks.


